Website Cookies

We send cookies from our website to your device to allow us to provide you with the best user experience we can. Cookies are small pieces of information that are stored by your browser on your computer's hard drive. They make it possible for us to provide our online ticketing service and track visitor statistics, such as returning visitors. Here you can see what cookies may be sent to your device by junction.co.uk and what we use each cookie for. You can control cookies within your browser by accessing the browser Help menu, but please be aware that if you choose to disable cookies, certain features of junction.co.uk may be disabled.

The cookies used on junction.co.uk fall into 3 categories:

Necessary

Necessary cookies help make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. The website cannot function properly without these cookies.

Statistics

Statistic cookies help website owners to understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously

Marketing

Marketing cookies are used to track visitors across websites. The intention is to display ads that are relevant and engaging for the individual user and thereby more valuable for publishers and third party advertisers.

The following first party cookies may be placed on your computer or device:

has_js	Registers whether or not the user has activated JavaScript in the browser.	Necessary
_ga	Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website.	Statistics
_gat	Used by Google Analytics to throttle request rate	Statistics
_gid	Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website.	Statistics

Third-party cookies

_ga	Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website.	spektrix.com	Statistics
_gat	Used by Google Analytics to throttle request rate	spektrix.com	Statistics
_gid	Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website.	spektrix.com	Statistics
vuid	Collects data on the user's visits to the website, such as which pages have been read.	Vimeo.com	Statistics
ads/ga-audiences	Used by Google AdWords to re-engage visitors that are likely to convert to customers based on the visitor's online behaviour across websites.	google.com	Marketing
collect	Used to send data to Google Analytics about the visitor's device and behaviour. Tracks the visitor across devices and marketing channels.	google-analytics.com	Marketing
GPS	Registers a unique ID on mobile devices to enable tracking based on geographical GPS location.	youtube.com	Marketing
NID	Registers a unique ID that identifies a returning user's device. The ID is used for targeted ads.	google.com	Marketing
PREF	Registers a unique ID that is used by Google to keep statistics of how the visitor uses YouTube videos across different websites.	youtube.com	Marketing
VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE	Tries to estimate the users' bandwidth on pages with integrated YouTube videos	youtube.com	Marketing
YSC	Registers a unique ID to keep statistics of what videos from YouTube the user has seen.	youtube.com	Marketing
